ST BRIGID'S CHURCH 27 WAKEMAN STREET, PAHIATUA OUR LADY OF CZĘSTOCHOWA – QUEEN OF POLAND

This image of Our Lady of Częstochowa, under the title Queen of Poland, was painted by Polish soldier Sergeant Major Feliks Krzewiński in Loreto, Italy, on 15 August 1944, during the Italian Campaign of World War II.

It was gifted to the children of the Polish Children's Camp in Pahiatua by soldiers of the Third Carpathian Division of the Polish Second Army Corps.

On the 70th anniversary of the beginning of their exile from Poland-marked by the 10 February 1940 deportations to Soviet forced labour camps—the former children entrusted the image to St Brigid's Church, Pahiatua. Their journey included over two years of detention in the USSR, followed by two years as refugees in Iran, before arriving in New Zealand on 31 October 1944.
